

Resources for Faculty Advisors of Students in Academic Probation 1 or 2

- Students whose cumulative GPA falls below 2.0 in a regular fall/spring semester will be put on Academic Probation 1 for the first semester. If their cumulative GPA remains below 2.0 (or falls below 2.0 again in the future), the student will be in Probation 2. Students in Probation 1 or 2 meet regularly with **Staff** in the SASRC (Student Academic Success and Retention Center)
- Faculty Advisors can play a role in helping students in Academic Probation plan a class schedule that will best help them reach the goal of getting back in Good Standing with the university as soon as possible. This may include **course selection, retaking courses, taking a reduced course load**, or referring students to get support from:
 - 1. The Peer Tutoring Program to improve course study
 - 2. English Language Center (ELC)
 - 3. Attending Academic Skills Workshops and Sharing Sessions (offered by the SASRC), etc...
 - 4. Counselling Center
 - 5. Student Career Development Center
